Details of the English test results for KKUIC Direct Admission 3rd round

The English language proficiency test which is an important tool for studying in international programs. The test results were divided into 3 groups, with the names of students as attached to the announcement as follows:

“PASS” means students PASS ESAP and can enroll in the regular courses in the first semester of 2021 listed in their programs.

“ESAP1” means the 1st year students need to study ESAP1 course in the first semester of 2021. ESAP1 student is available to enroll in regular courses for a maximum of 3 courses together with an ESAP course.

ESAP2” means the 1st year students need to study ESAP2 course in the first semester of 2021. ESAP2 student is available to enroll in regular courses for a maximum of 3 courses together with an ESAP course.

The students listed in the groups of ESAP1 and ESAP2, must enroll for the ESAP courses in the academic year 1/2021. (The class start July, 12 2021) A student is available to enroll in regular courses for a maximum of 3 courses together with an ESAP course in the academic year 1/2021 and can cause the student’s late graduation. The detail as follows:

English for Specific Academic Purposes (ESAP)

Course Description:

The English for Specific Academic Purposes (ESAP) is designed for students who need to improve their English language skills and plan to continue their study at the university level.

Course Objectives:

The course aims to improve the English language proficiency at higher levels and be able to study their interested international majors effectively. The students who have been identified as having a low level of English attainment, so that by the end of the course, they can actively participate in mainstream university courses to an international standard.

Students are to successfully demonstrate the following English language and study skills:

1. Academic skills: summarizing, paraphrasing, making predictions, identifying gist
2. English language skills: listening, speaking, reading and writing

ESAP Courses:

1. English for Specific Academic Purposes (ESAP1)

1.1 Students, who finish ESAP1 in the summer period and have an Exit Test score from 0% - 49% and new students who are required to study ESAP1, will study ESAP1 course for 135 hours during the first semester and enroll in three General Education courses (the class schedule and list of courses will be announced later on www.ic.kku.ac.th).

1.2 This course provides General English for the first 70 hours and the proceeding 65 hours is Academic English. All four skills will be covered in each class, as following the Communicative Language Teaching style.

1.3 After the 135 hours of study, the students will take the ESAP1 Exit test, and the criteria of the test results are:

Criteria	Result
0% – 49%	Study ESAP1 course in the second semester and register for three KkuIC General Education courses, which will be suggested in the announcement of the exit test results.
50% – 79%	Study ESAP2 course in the second semester and register for three KkuIC General Education courses, which will be suggested in the announcement of the exit test results.
80% – 100%	Exit ESAP and register for the regular courses listed in their programs.

1.4 ESAP1 course is instructed in the first semester, the fee for this course is included in the semester tuition fee, so the students do not pay for ESAP1 course.

1.5 The books used in this course is Empower A2

2. English for Specific Academic Purposes (ESAP2)

2.1 Students who finish ESAP1 in the summer period and have an Exit Test score from 50% – 79%, will study ESAP2 course for 135 hours in the first semester and enroll in three General Education courses (the class schedule and list of courses will be announced later on www.ic.kku.ac.th).

2.2 Students who finish ESAP1 in the first semester and have an Exit Test score from 50% - 79%, will study ESAP2 for 135 hours in the second semester and enroll in three General Education courses (the class schedule and list of courses will be announced later on www.ic.kku.ac.th).

2.3 This course will provide General English for the first 70 hours and the proceeding 65 hours will be Academic English. All four skills will be covered in each class, as following the Communicative Language Teaching style.

2.4 After the 135 hours of study, the students will take the ESAP2 Exit test, and the criteria of the test results are:

Criteria	Result
0% – 79%	3.1 Study ESAP2 course in the next semester and register for three KKUIC General Education courses, which will be suggested in the announcement of the exit test results. 3.2 Students need to contact the academic staff for the suggestion.
80% – 100%	Exit ESAP and register for the regular courses listed in their programs.

2.5 ESAP 2 course is instructed in the first or second semester, the fee for this course is included in the semester tuition fee, so the students do not pay for ESAP2 course.

2.6 The books used in this course is Empower B1.

3. To Exit ESAP:

3.1 Students who study each ESAP course and have the Exit Test score from 80% - 100%, will exit the ESAP course.

3.2 Students who do not pass the exit test of the last ESAP course of the academic year need to contact KKUIC staff, where each student will be considered on an individual basis, and given suggestions on the options and what courses they may study next.
